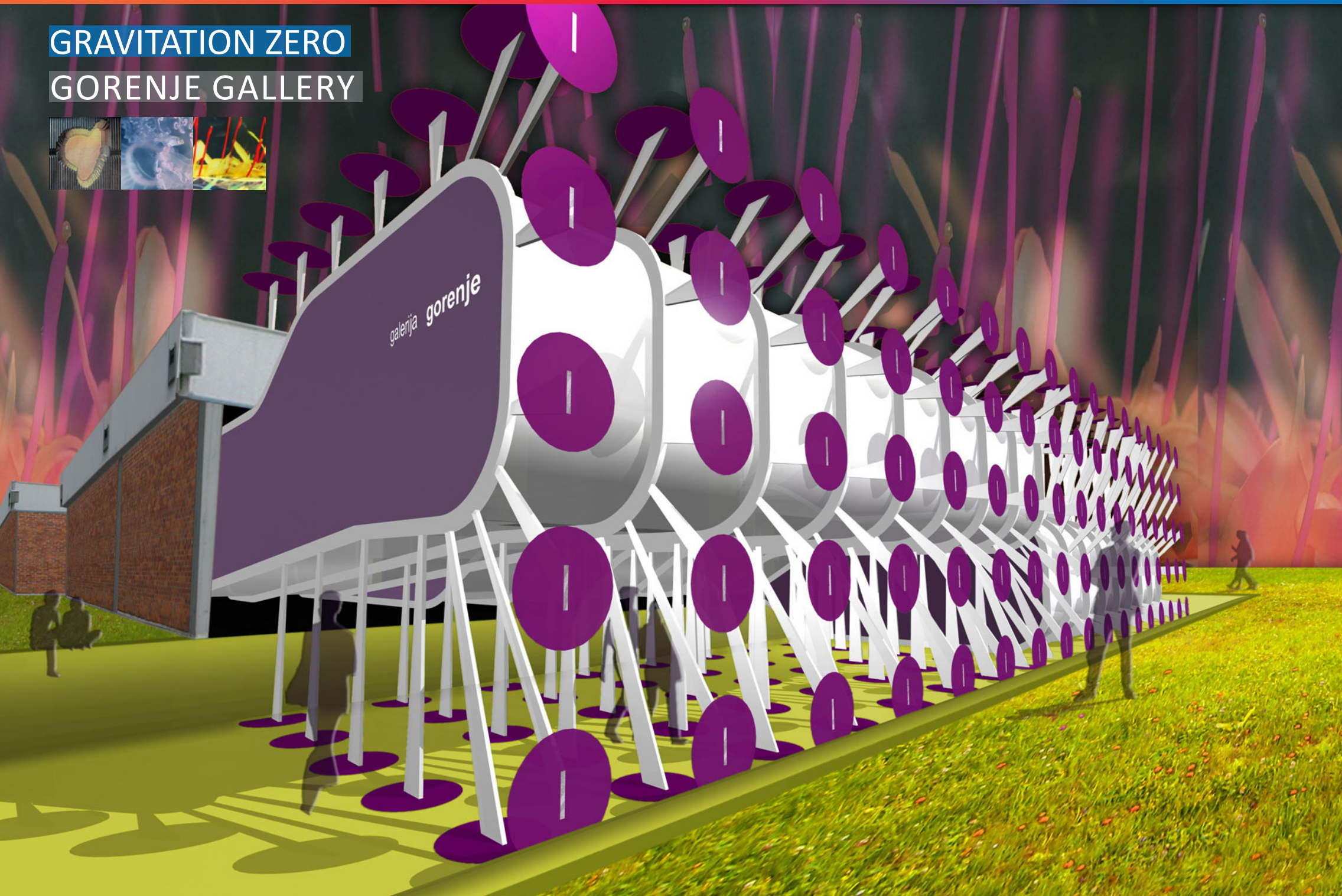
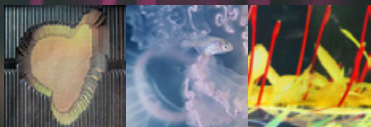
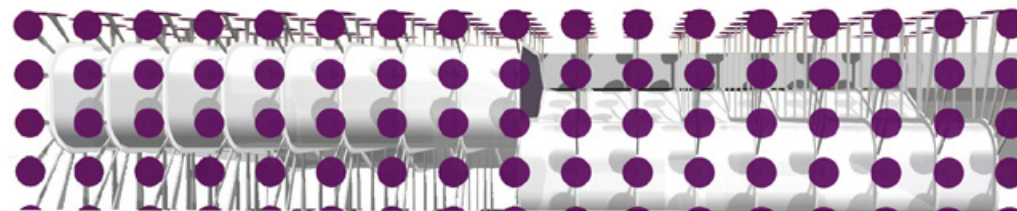
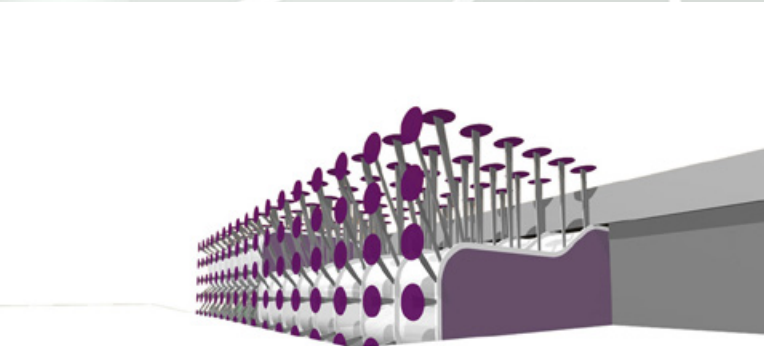
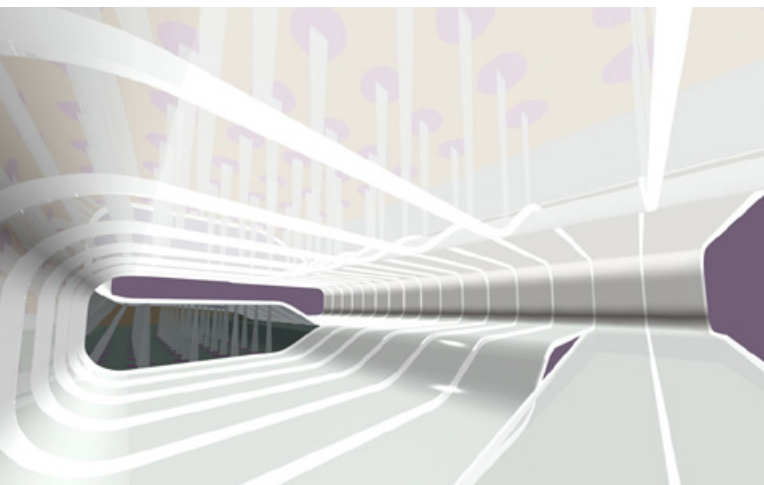
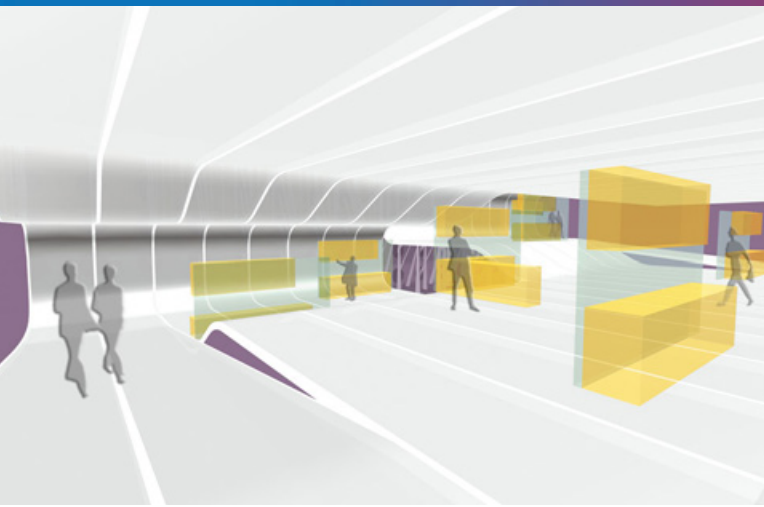


GRAVITATION ZERO GORENJE GALLERY





The investor wants a newly designed space, a gallery, which would be representative in the sense of occurrence in space, but at the same time offer quality spaces to showcase Gorenje kitchens. The company has three types of kitchens, which they want to present in the shape of a glasshouse of some kind.

According to the investor's wishes and the requirements of the exhibited kitchens we created a seemingly never-ending space. The floor visually flows into the wall, the wall flows further on into the ceiling. Because of the need for three separate spaces, the closed spatial band shifts vertically and at the same time creates a roofed entrance into the gallery. The facade is made of standard joints, combined with glass and aluminium.
