PUBLIC TRANSPORTATION BUILDING





The new Passenger Center Celje sits at the railway and bus station junction, reinterpreting the central square to link the historic core with modern mobility. The space between stations forms an urban carpet blending movement, landscape, and public life, while the building creates a new southern gateway. **BREAKTHRU**'s rounded, aerodynamic form with textile "sails" reflects motion and flow.

The masterplan features four thematic parks - Bus, Solar, Urban, and Railway - creating a unified public space with greenery. A rooftop solar field supports energy autonomy, while the flexible structure and reconstructed Šubič Pavilion connect the city's past to its future.
