CONTEXT

EMBRACE transforms an agricultural building into a semi-detached house for living and rental. Located at the forest edge, it reinterprets the existing structure into an open, welcoming environment with two separate units and preserved character.

CONCEPT

The design retains the original volume, adding triangular extensions with service spaces and terraces. Openings face east-west for privacy, with entrances on the south. The extensions “embrace” the building, giving it a new identity and transforming it into a contemporary home.
